The Tufted Titmouse is a very rare and local resident species in the Greater Toronto Area. There is anecdotal evidence that it may have bred in both the Regional Municipalities of *Peel* and *Halton* in the early 1960s, but confirmed evidence of breeding in the GTA is still lacking after more than 40 years of continuous occurrence. Its confirmation as a breeding bird on the Toronto bird checklist is long overdue.

- **WESTERN GREBE** 1 at S end of the Endikement, LSS on 10<sup>th</sup> (Bob Kortright,TFN, fide ONTBIRDS) was first reported as Clark's Grebe. It was relocated at 9:20hrs on 11<sup>th</sup> and identified as Western Grebe [No doc. seen] (RLau,GC, JRC, &), and was seen by many observers later that day. It continued to be reported: being seen again on 17<sup>th</sup> (JFa, RBHS,WP); 18<sup>th</sup> (Bob Kortright fide ONTBIRDS); 24<sup>th</sup> (Bob Kortright fide ONTBIRDS); and 25<sup>th</sup> (NMu, Ed O'Connor), when it was heard to give a double note call (NMu). Still present on 31<sup>st</sup>, when it was quite distant and hard to see well due to moderate E wind and waves 1m (RBHS,WP). All sightings were off the S end of the Endikement, the SE Tip, or the 'Flats'. Photos of varying quality were obtained by: RLau, JI, JRC; lain Fleming (posted on OUTON, later on OFO website), and WP on 11<sup>th</sup>; and by WP on 17<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>. Based on initial photos, a couple of experts suggested it could be an 'intermediate type' or hybrid, but others favoured Western. Over the following weeks it appeared to get a little darker around the lores and eyes and the general opinion shifted to Western (subject of course to OBRC review).

Include technical details if you wish, particularly for flight or 'action' shots. Preference will be given to photos by TOC members, taken within the GTA, and during the relevant period, but we cannot guarantee that any particular photo will be used.
