#### Fieldfare (Turdus pilaris)

This Fieldfare was photographed on 14 August 2007 at Viikki, near Helsinki, Finland. All four photos depict the same individual. Godfrey (1996) listed seven records of Fieldfare for Canada, of which three were Ontario records. The first of these was reported on 8 Jan 1967 at Rockcliffe Park, Ottawa, *Ottawa-Carleton* by H.N. MacKenzie (MacKenzie 1968), the next was trapped and banded at the 'Breakwater' field station on Long Point, *Norfolk Co.* on 24 May 1975 (Hussell and Porter 1977), and the third was a long-stayer seen in *Toronto* between 1 Jan and Mar 1981. Although originally mentioned (*Toronto Star* of 11 January 1981) with only a vague location, birders soon narrowed it down to the Kipling/Eglinton area of Etobicoke (Bennett 1981). "It was seen by thousands of birders and possibly hundreds of others went away frustrated" (Goodwin 1981). The first of these three records has been accepted by OBRC (Wormington 1985), while the other two have apparently not been reviewed by OBRC, but are generally accepted. Perhaps we are overdue for another one?

At first glance the Fieldfare resembles an immature American Robin, but closer looks at the breast pattern and especially the grey rump would definitely identify the bird. From late fall to winter is probably the best time to watch out for a vagrant bird.

The following are largely unchecked reports, not authenticated records. Key to counties: DU = Durham R.M.; HL = Halton R.M.; PL = Peel R.M.; MT = City of Toronto; LO = Lake Ontario Pelagic; YO = York R.M. [County not specified for sites in Toronto]. Frequently cited place names in Toronto are abbreviated as follows: CSSP = Colonel Sam Smith Park; HP = High Park; HBP = Humber Bay Park (E or W); LSS = Leslie Street Spit; TI = Toronto Islands. Other abbreviations: HFR, DRF, YRF = Halton, Durham and York Regional Forests, respectively. TBO = Toronto Bird Observatory; TTPBRS = Tommy Thompson Park Bird Research Station.

Species names in **bold, underlined BLOCK CAPITALS** are OBRC rarities. These reports require acceptance by OBRC before they can be considered as part of the local records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Species names in **bold** (but not underlined) are local rarities within the GTA. These reports require acceptance by the Toronto Bird Rarities Committee (TBRC) before they can be considered as valid records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Individual species marked \* or specific reports marked \* indicate unusual local observations for which documentation is requested by TBRC and/or TOC Records Committee by virtue of rarity, difficulty of ID, extreme dates (early, late, unseasonal) or high counts.

Species names in [square brackets] indicate reports believed to relate to escaped or released birds, or to introduced birds which have not yet become established.

Names in *ITALICS* indicate subspecies, hybrids, morphs or other 'recognizable forms', which may be identifiable in the field. This does not necessarily imply that the compilers agree with such designations, or accept their validity.

AMERICAN WHITE PELICAN - 1 flying W along Lake Ontario shore, off Cranberry Marsh [DU] @ 13:30hrs on 29<sup>th</sup> (CMRW fide RPye, fide RJP). It was relocated at Frenchman's Bay [DU] later in the afternoon & then flew back eastward (Jim Skene fide RPye, fide DRBA). At 18:00hrs it was seen off Lynde Shores C.A. [DU] (anon fide

RPye, fide DRBA). On the 30<sup>th</sup> the bird was seen again on Lake Ontario off the Lynde Marsh, 08:00-09:30h. (anon fide RPye, fide DRBA) and then seen flying W at Cranberry Marsh [DU] @ 09:30hrs (CMRW fide RPye, fide DRBA). At 10:15hrs it was seen 1km N of Hwy 401 above Rouge River circling and drifting N (ADob fide ONTBIRDS). Later the same day, what was most likely the same bird was reported off Princess Point at Cootes Paradise [HW] @ 18:00hrs (BChar, RD, CEdge), having been found earlier by Kevin McLaughlin, Ken & Angie Williams and Jeff Gilbreath, while looking for a Franklin's Gull in the Dundas Marsh. ## Pamper Your Arms – Use a Finnstick Winnie Poon

During a recent visit to Helsinki, Finland, Roy Smith and I noticed that the Finnish birders often carried a short stick along with their birding gear. The stick was usually about 1.5 feet long, it had some form of attachment device at one end that supported the binoculars in a viewing position without having to hold on to them. Instead the person only held on to the stick and rested the arms against his body for stability (Figure 1).

One such stick that we saw actually had a small threaded cap installed at one end, which allowed it to be securely attached to the end of his Zeiss binoculars; the stick just dangled from the bins. Another younger birder made use of an axe handle plus a self-made molded triangular piece that wedged very snugly into the space between the two binocular barrels (Figure 1). A third invention made use of a tripod attachment plate, a metal bar and a very strong elastic band (Figure 2).

We had a chance to try using the axe-stick. It was unbelievably good, the images were absolutely stable and clear. At once I felt the advantage of resting my arms. As a young birder back in Britain Roy had heard of the Finnstick, but had never actually seen anyone there using one. Likewise, during the last twenty years of birding in North America we have never seen a Finnstick. In reality the Finnstick is rarely found or used outside Finland.

An introduction to the Finnstick can be found in *Birding*, under Tools of the Trade (Forsten & Collins 1993). However, the Finnstick never gained popularity here; true to what the authors said, birders were probably shy to use it in North America. It may also be related to a style of birding in Finland, favoured by their many blinds and birding 'Towers'.

It is not difficult to make your own Finnstick. The following are some informative websites that give instructions:
