GREATER TORONTO AREA BIRD REPORT – MAY 2008

The following are largely unchecked reports, not authenticated records. County/Region codes used in the *database* are: MT = City of Toronto; HL = Halton R.M.; PL = Peel R.M.; YO = York R.M.; DU = Durham R.M.; LO = Lake Ontario Pelagic, but full names are provided in the Report, except for locations within City of Toronto. Frequently cited place names in Toronto are abbreviated as follows: CSSP = Colonel Sam Smith Park; HP = High Park; HBP = Humber Bay Park (E or W); LSS = Leslie Street Spit; TI = Toronto Islands. Other abbreviations: HRF, DRF, YRF = Halton, Durham and York Regional Forests, respectively. TBO = Toronto Bird Observatory; TTPBRS = Tommy Thompson Park Bird Research Station.

Species names in **bold, underlined BLOCK CAPITALS** are OBRC rarities. These reports require acceptance by OBRC before they can be considered as part of the local records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Species names in **bold** (but not underlined) are local rarities within the GTA. These reports require documentation and acceptance by the Toronto Bird Rarities Committee (TBRC) before they can be considered as valid records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Individual species **marked * or specific reports marked *** indicate unusual local observations for which documentation is requested by TBRC and/or TOC Records Committee by virtue of rarity, difficulty of ID, extreme dates (early, late, unseasonal) or high counts.

Species names in [square brackets] indicate reports believed to relate to escaped or released birds, or to introduced birds which have not yet become established.

Names in *ITALICS* indicate subspecies, hybrids, morphs or other 'recognizable forms', which may be identifiable in the field. This does not necessarily imply that the compilers agree with such designations, or accept their validity.

It slipped off the nest and swam off, only to be snatched by a RBGU. The adults appeared quite disinterested, 6 or 7 eggs remain in nest. A second nest started on another tire.

MISSISSIPPI KITE - 1 IMM at West Deane Park on 18th [No doc. seen] (AA) was seen crossing the valley from W to E. 1 at Darlington Prov. Park, *Durham* @ 07:17hrs on 18th [No doc. seen] (THo fide ONTBIRDS). 'Just after 7am while watching the jaeger I noticed a bird a few km offshore coming straight over from NY State. It looked like raptor that was seriously regretted [sic] trying to cross a cool lake at dawn. As it approached the beach I was finally able to ID it as Mississippi Kite'. Flew off NE.

The status of Baird's Sandpiper as a spring migrant in the Greater Toronto Area

Baird's Sandpiper (*Calidris bairdii*) undertakes one of the longest and most rapid migrations of any North American bird species, travelling up to 15,000 kilometres in spring in as little as five weeks (O'Brien *et al.* 2006). It migrates from its southern South American wintering grounds (from Ecuador and southern Brazil to southern Chile and Argentina), overflying much of Central America, and up through a narrow corridor of the Great Plains and Canadian Prairies (staying to the west of both the Mississippi watershed and Hudson Bay), on the way to its breeding grounds on the sparsely-vegetated dry tundra habitat of the High Arctic (from the Chukotski Peninsula of eastern Siberia, across all of the Canadian Arctic islands, to northwestern Greenland).

Baird's Sandpiper is mainly an insectivore, and northbound migrants favour grasslands, flooded pastures, prairies, rice and alfalfa fields, and alpine tundra meadows, earning it the reputation as a "grasspiper" (Moskoff and Montgomerie 2002).

Spring sightings of adult Baird's Sandpipers away from their central flyway migratory corridor are quite rare. Migrants appear in the Great Plains states from mid-March to mid-May, often staging for a period before heading to their Arctic breeding grounds (Moskoff and Montgomerie 2002). They typically arrive on territory at their breeding grounds from late May to early June (Parmelee *et al.* 1967).

Fleming (1906) did not list any spring records or specimens for Baird's Sandpiper in the Toronto area. James (1991) considered Baird's Sandpiper to be a *rare spring migrant* in Ontario between mid-April and early June. Curry (2006) characterized it as an *extremely rare spring transient*, listing only seven records from the Hamilton area between 12 April and 8 June. Tozer and Richards (1974) considered it a *rare spring transient* in the Oshawa-Scugog area, citing only four records between 16 May and 3 June. Speirs (1977) listed it as a *rare spring migrant*, noting only six records from Pickering to Whitby between 16 May and 3 June. Goodwin (1988) notably mentioned it only in the context of fall migration, citing no spring records at all for Toronto. At Presqu'île Provincial Park, LaForest (1993) considered it a *rare spring migrant*, citing eight spring records between 4 May and 12 June. In the Kingston region, Weir (1989) considered it a *rare and irregular spring migrant*, citing records in only six years, spanning dates ranging from 8 to 31 May.

Baird's Sandpiper is clearly a very rare spring migrant in southern Ontario. In 50 years of very active birding in our area, Jim Baillie only saw a single Baird's Sandpiper in spring. In 35+ years of birding in southern Ontario, I have only seen a lone Baird's Sandpiper in spring (by comparison, I have seen more Wilson's Plovers and Curlew Sandpipers in Ontario in spring in that time!). The majority of long-time birders in our area have never seen a Baird's Sandpiper locally in spring.

In the database of the Toronto Ornithological Club, there are 22 reports of spring occurrences of Baird's Sandpiper in the Greater Toronto Area (GTA). Some of these involve known or suspected misidentifications, and others have little details upon which to make any substantive determination. I have provided a list of those 15 reports (Table 1) which I feel likely involved genuine spring records of Baird's Sandpiper in the GTA. This is simply based on my own personal assessment of the merits of individual reports, and may overestimate the true number of accurate records. None of the records involve specimens, and only one record involves photographic evidence. The remaining records lack any written description, or much else in the way of documentation.

It would appear clear that very few adult Baird's Sandpipers are found in the GTA in spring migration. There are no records prior to 1956. Only one record involves more than a single bird, and no records involve

flocks of birds. Occurrences are not even close to annual, and gaps of more than a decade between spring sightings are not unusual. The present range of dates of occurrence spans the period 16 May to 9 June.

What factors may contribute to an over-reporting of Baird's Sandpiper in the GTA in spring? I believe the most prevalent reason is the unfamiliarity of inexperienced observers with its rare status as a spring migrant in our area (and hence a lack of sufficient scrutiny). Another factor that undoubtedly leads to its over-reporting is simply the unfamiliarity of eastern North American observers with the breeding plumage of Baird's Sandpiper. Unless observers have spent a lot of time at migration spots on the Great Plains or on the High Arctic breeding grounds, most Ontario birders have little experience with adult Baird's Sandpipers in breeding plumage. Additionally, observers probably underestimate the possibility of mistaking the adult Semipalmated Sandpiper for Baird's Sandpiper. Despite the size difference between the two species, differences in their bill structure, their primary length, and the presence or absence or partially webbed toes, solitary birds may present difficulty, particularly when other species are not available for comparison. Godfrey (1986) is one of the few authors that pointed out the striking similarity of the breeding plumages of Baird's Sandpiper and Semipalmated Sandpiper, a dilemma which observers first seeing the two species together in the Arctic quickly learn to appreciate. The separation of Baird's Sandpiper from the similarly-sized White-rumped Sandpiper in breeding plumage, although fairly straightforward, can also present challenges in birds that are not seen under ideal conditions.

In the future, the growing trend toward digiscoping should provide for the possibility of additional spring records of Baird's Sandpiper in the GTA that are supported by good material evidence. Like specimens, these will serve to provide a more solid basis upon which future authors may re-evaluate the historical records.
