Like any good photograph, our cover image, taken from the TOC Archives, tells an interesting story. Back in the 1930's an area of wet fields called York Downs (the present day area bounded by Wilson and Sheppard, from Bathurst west to Dufferin Street), formed a rich birding area, now almost completely swallowed up by urbanization. But at that time it supported good numbers of wintering Short-eared Owls, while breeding species included American Bittern and Pied-billed Grebe, and even territorial Le Conte's Sparrows could be found. In 1937, a Henslow's Sparrow nest was discovered by D.S.Miller in an 'ungrazed wet pasture field'. It was said to be the 2nd nest for the '*Toronto* area'. Had it been thirty years earlier, this nest would have probably been collected, but by the 1930's, field guides, binoculars and cameras were replacing the shotgun as a keen birder's primary field equipment. Given the technology of that time it is understandable that the young had to be removed from the nest and lined up on a towel, presumably to provide enough light for the image! Today it is most unlikely that any of us will ever get to see a Henslow's Sparrow nest anywhere in Ontario, let alone within the GTA!

This photograph of an adult Henslow's Sparrow feeding five nestlings was taken on 15 June 1937, by Charles E. Molony. It was found in the album of Otto E. Devitt (1904-1992). The TOC Archives contain many other interesting items awaiting rediscovery. *Roy Smith*

The following are largely unchecked reports, not authenticated records. County/Region codes used in the *database* are: MT = City of Toronto; HL = Halton R.M.; PL = Peel R.M.; YO = York R.M.; DU = Durham R.M.; LO = Lake Ontario Pelagic, but full names are provided in the Report, except for locations within City of Toronto. Frequently cited place names in Toronto are abbreviated as follows: CSSP = Colonel Sam Smith Park; HP = High Park; HBP = Humber Bay Park (E or W); LSS = Leslie Street Spit; TI = Toronto Islands. Other abbreviations: HRF, DRF, YRF = Halton, Durham and York Regional Forests, respectively. TBO = Toronto Bird Observatory; TTPBRS = Tommy Thompson Park Bird Research Station.

Species names in **bold, underlined <u>BLOCK CAPITALS</u>** are OBRC rarities. These reports require acceptance by OBRC before they can be considered as part of the local records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Species names in **bold** (but not underlined) are local rarities within the GTA. These reports require documentation and acceptance by the Toronto Bird Rarities Committee (TBRC) before they can be considered as valid records. They are qualified by [Documentation received] or [No documentation received], as applicable.

Individual species **marked * or specific reports marked *** indicate unusual local observations for which documentation is requested by TBRC and/or TOC Records Committee by virtue of rarity, difficulty of ID, extreme dates (early, late, unseasonal) or high counts.

Species names in [square brackets] indicate reports believed to relate to escaped or released birds, or to introduced birds which have not yet become established.

Names in *ITALICS* indicate subspecies, hybrids, morphs or other 'recognizable forms', which may be identifiable in the field. This does not necessarily imply that the compilers agree with such designations, or accept their validity.

The TOC – Royal Ontario Museum Connection

From its earliest days, the Toronto Ornithological Club (TOC) has had strong connections with the Royal Ontario Museum (ROM). The legendary James L. Baillie was a founding member of TOC (1934) while Lester L. Snyder, whose career at the ROM spanned 46 years, was also a TOC member for many vears. Today (2008), the tradition is continued with both Mark Peck (Collections Manager, Ornithology) and current club President Kevin Seymour. being staff appointees at the ROM.

With the recent influx of new members into TOC, some may not be aware that the ROM Library and Archives hold a considerable number of archival collec-

tions relating to ornithology. In addition, the TOC's own archives are housed there. These <u>Special</u> <u>Collections</u> provide a unique and fascinating window into the ornithological activities of some former TOC members, and others. They comprise a valuable resource for anyone conducting research into the ornithological history of the GTA or investigating historic bird records. Of the some 70 collections listed about one-third are those of former TOC members and/or hold materials for the Toronto area. Probably the largest collection is that of James H. Fleming, the noted ornithologist and collector who left his archives as well as his book and specimen collections to ROM. Other smaller collections of TOC members besides those of Baillie and Snyder include those of Ott Devitt, Clifford Hope, Eric Nasmith, Charles Richards, Richard Saunders and Terry Shortt. Most collections include bird records of one type or another.

Historically, TOC has always been interested in bird records, and the TOC Archives contain the original Record Books, in which observations reported at Club meetings were recorded in longhand by the Secretary. These Record Books span the period 1934 to 1986. The following table provides an introduction to the <u>Special Collections</u>. More detailed descriptions of the holdings as well as the collections themselves can be viewed in ROM Library and Archives.
